You can read, study, surf the Internet or visit our events. You do not need a library card for any of this.

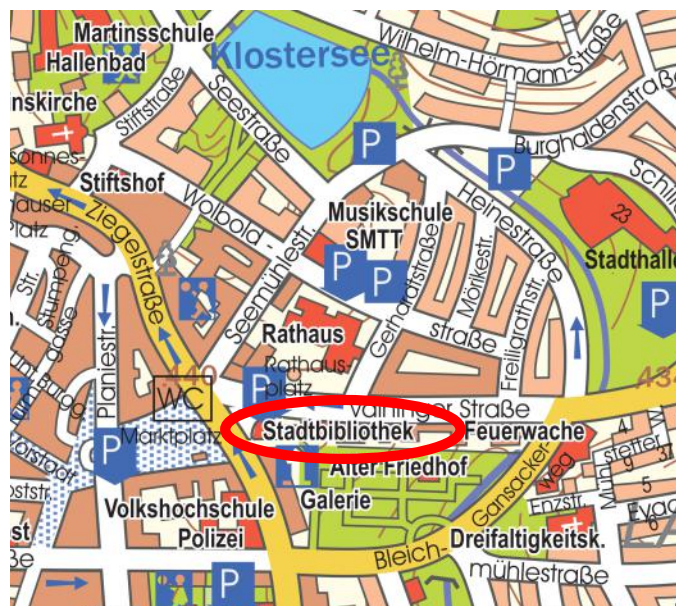
If you want to take out items and bring them home, then you will need to register. Please bring your passport and an official proof of address (Personalausweis, Aufenthaltstitel or Meldebescheinigung etc).

Fees:

Children and Teens up to 18 years:	free of charge
Adults:	16 € / year
Special rates (students etc):	8 € / year
Holders of the Berechtigungskarte, kindergardens and schools:	free of charge
One-Day-Pass for 4 items:	3 €

Extra costs will apply for items overdue.

An overview of offers and items available in the library

For Children

Fiction & Nonfiction: Reading exciting, scary or funny stories and comics or interesting non fiction books improves German language skills immensely.

Items to learn German: the library has picturebook dictionaries and language courses for children.

Items for school and homework: including German, Maths, English.

Audiobooks: learning German is fun when listening to stories, fairytales, rhymes and songs.

Events: Storytime, crafting or picture book cinema every Wednesday at 3:00 pm.

For Adults

The library section “**German as a foreign Language**”: books, language courses, audiobooks, software and grammar training to help you learn German. Also available: study and test books for the Goethe certificate.

The library section “**easy reads**” consists of fiction for adults and teens who are beginning to learn German.

Audiobooks: listening to stories and learning German.

There is also a big selection of **newspapers and magazines** available, for example “Deutsch perfekt”.

Non fiction books and guidebooks can help you in nearly all situations in life.

Music CDs, DVDs, console games (NintendoDS, Playstation 4, Switch and Wii) and other items for your entertainment.

For everyone

In total there are 75.000 Books, CDs, DVDs, magazines and other items available in the library.

Free WIFI and Internet for all visitors.

There are 30.000 items (for example eBooks) for kids and adults available in the **OnlinebibliothekBB**. This includes: Audiobooks, study books and fiction.
